DIRECTIONS TO OAK HILL ANIMAL CLINIC: From the Lake County Fairgrounds go north on South Court Street toward Grace Court (1.2 mi total). Turn right onto West Joliet Street/US-231/IN-55. Continue to follow US-231 for 2.3 mi. 209 W. State Road 231 is on the right.

DIRECTIONS TO CALUMET EMERGENCY VETERINARIAN CLINIC: From Lake County Fairgrounds go north on Court Street to Greenwood and turn right. Take Greenwood east to Main Street and turn left onto Main Street. Take Main Street north past Crown Point Courthouse. Continue north, Main Street turns into Route 55. Take Route 55 north to US 30. At US 30 turn left and proceed west approximately 5 mi. to Lincoln Ridge Plaza. Calumet Emergency Veterinary Clinic is in the plaza.

DIRECTIONS TO MATCH SITE:

From Borman Expressway/I-80-94 from East and West: Exit at I-65 south to Route 231; west to stoplight at Route 55 south. Travel south on Route 55 to stoplight at Greenwood; west on Greenwood to Court Street. Turn south; Lake County Fairgrounds is on the west side of Court Street.

From I-65 South and North: Exit Route 231 west and follow above directions.

Crown Point, IN is on Central Time
(Same time as Chicago, IL)

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

All dogs must be on a short leash and under control while on grounds. Approved collars include flat snap or buckle collars of solid construction and leather or nylon leads. Limited slip martingale collars are allowed. Single piece slip collars/leads are allowed. Harnesses, with the exception of head-halter types, are allowed. Dogs MUST run "naked," without a collar/harness. Collars/harnesses which can be easily and quickly removed and replaced are strongly encouraged. NO flexi-leads allowed.

RUNNING ORDER/SCHEDULE: Small to Large.

NOTE:	7:15 a.m.-7:45 a.m. Check in, Registration 8:00 a.m. Instinct briefing 8:15 a.m. Instinct Test Novice class to follow Instinct Test
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Dogs will be run in height order with dogs being handled by the same person separated into different staged groups.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Dogs 13" and under, small Dogs 13.1 to 18", medium Dogs over 18", large

Bitches in season are eligible for entry but will be required to be kept separate from all other dogs and will be run in panties at the end of their class.

Entry fees for bitches that come into season will be refunded until November 12, 2014, if you wish to withdraw. If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the match committee prior to the match, and you must inform all exhibitors at the judge's briefing.

A hard-sided crate for your dog is required.

PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG(S).

Cleaning supplies available in Annex building as well as outside.

Crating space available in Annex building-**first come/first served.**

Coffee and water will be available at match site. There are plenty of fast food establishments within a short driving distance from the Lake County Fairgrounds.
